What is live now

The release already includes a public landing page, raw JSON, release text, short aliases, an Atom feed, and a machine-discovery summary. This package adds a press brief, share image, multilingual copy, checksums, and a mirror zip.

The normative recommendations are stable. The war-status context is explicitly marked as a dated snapshot and should be refreshed before republishing as current fact.

Verification and sources

The v1.1 release adds explicit source metadata, confidence labels, and last-verified dates for the highest-impact factual context. The protocol does not claim that every operational detail is independently resolved; it marks mixed-confidence areas and preserves provenance.
